


## BYLAW 2018-1


### A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF KENOSEE LAKE TO ASSESS AND LEVY THE COST OF FIRE PROTECTION, SUPPRESSION AND EMERGENCY SERVICES

The Council of the Village of Kenosee Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
  - a. "Municipality" shall mean the Village of Kenosee Lake
  - b. "Service Provider" shall mean a municipality, co-operative, board or other entity who has been engaged by the Municipality to provide the fire prevention, suppression or other emergency response service.
2. Fire suppression and or prevention services shall be delivered on behalf of the Village of Kenosee Lake by the Village of Kenosee Volunteer Fire Department.
3. Fees relative to the services identified in Section 2 of this bylaw shall be established by the Municipality as per Schedule "A" as attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.
4. The Municipality shall charge the cost of the fire prevention and suppression services directly to the person or persons who receive the service. Any additional services that may be needed in the suppression of the fire shall be the responsibility of the person or persons who receives the service.
5. If all or a portion of the charge noted in Schedule "A" remain unpaid after 90 days of the invoice date, the Municipality may add the amount owing to the taxes on any parcel of land owned by the person.
6. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the third and final reading thereof.
7. Bylaw No. 4-2008 is hereby repealed.

***Schedule "A"***  
***To Bylaw 2018-1***

1. Fire suppression fees are as follows:
  - \$500 for the first hour (includes firefighters) base fee.
  - \$100 per hour for each additional hour for fire truck.
  - \$20.00 per hour for each additional hour for each firefighter

**Every call out is subject to the \$500 base fee.**
